Objective

Support the Casa del Noce renovation package by transforming existing technical projects into a coherent survey, drawing, interior-design, and implementation-support dossier for roof works, attic bathroom planning, internal partitions, and CILA-related non-structural documentation.

ConI, Eligibility, and Responsibilities

Standard Intel proposals are intended for students actively enrolled, at the moment of application and activation, in a European university or equivalent recognised higher-education institution. Non-standard cases require separate legal review before acceptance.

Every candidate must read the current ConI Internship Agreement before submitting a final application. ConI governs responsibilities, insurance, academic activation, confidentiality, intellectual-property access, and the distinction between an educational internship and employment.

Minimum Candidate Profile

The candidate must be able to read technical renovation documents, work safely in buildings under assessment, produce or update drawings, and distinguish design support from legally reserved professional certification. Preferred skills include AutoCAD, Revit, Archicad, SketchUp, Rhino, structural awareness, interior material boards, construction sequencing, Italian building-code awareness, and photographic survey discipline.

Work Plan

The internship work plan must allocate all expected hours to concrete phases and must match the ECTS/CFU value declared in the quantitative data block.

1	Read EC-NO-001 to EC-NO-004, map open decisions, legal/professional stop-points, and required drawings.	35
2	Perform or organize photographic survey, dimensional checks, room schedule, material notes, and issue register.	50
3	Develop roof, attic bathroom, partition, and interior-layout support drawings or BIM/CAD updates.	80
4	Prepare interior-design options, material boards, cost/supplier comparison, and phasing notes.	50
5	Support construction-management documentation: safety boundaries, procurement list, site checklist, and handover notes.	55
6	Deliver final renovation support report, drawing package, presentation, and candidate thesis/project reflection.	30

Deliverables and Evaluation

Survey register; updated drawing package or BIM/CAD package; room-by-room design notes; material and supplier comparison; construction phasing memo; CILA-support evidence index; safety and professional-boundary checklist; final report; and presentation for ColivingLiguria.

Operational Boundaries

The intern may support design, survey, drawing, documentation, and planning. The intern may not sign reserved professional documents, certify structural safety, approve work-at-height procedures, replace the appointed technician, or authorize construction works independently. Structural or safety-critical issues must be escalated.

Future Collaboration Path

A successful internship may lead to future personal or professional collaboration, where legally and academically compatible. ColivingLiguria and the Commenda project may also help suitable graduates identify European, regional, or national funding calls to start their professional path during or after university.
